WHAT

GDPR is the main data protection law in the UK – it's well-written, logical and relatively easy to read. The DPA 2018 is the engine that drives GDPR's high-level principles. It ensures that GDPR applies to areas that it wouldn't otherwise cover, it sets out exemptions from normal practice and safeguards for processing special categories data, and the rules for processing criminal records. It also introduces two distinct data protection regime for law enforcement bodies and the intelligence services (NB: spies should note that this last aspect will not be a big feature of the course).
