IMPACT ASSESSMENTS

DPIAs are mandatory for high risk processing, but they are also a great opportunity to ensure that important business processes or changes do not get hampered by Data Protection problems. It's difficult if a new project or product has been developed without thinking about the implications of the GDPR, and DP issues arise once it has been implemented. Far easier to scope the risks out in advance and mitigate them while it is cheap and easy to do so, even if the assessment was not mandatory.

AUDITS

The Information Commissioner sometimes makes an audit seem like a threat – and they have used them as a method of soft enforcement. This course will teach you how to set up a positive, effective assessment of your organisation's compliance with the GDPR, but more importantly, whether you are complying with your own policies and procedures.
