

LAWFUL BASES

GOTTA GET ONE OF THEM!

Article 6 of the UK GDPR



(1)A: CONSENT

The subject agrees to the data use - their agreement must be freely given, specific, informed and unambiguous, demonstrated through a clear action

(1)B: CONTRACT

You are using the data to service the requirements of a contract that exists between you and the subject

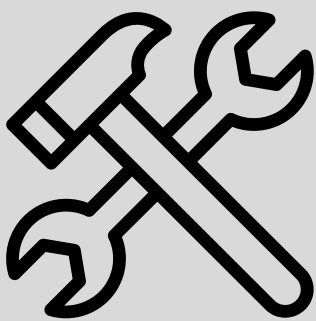


(1)C: LEGAL OBLIGATION

Using the data is necessary to comply with a specific legal obligation that your organisation has to comply with

(1)D: VITAL INTERESTS

Using the data is necessary to protect a person from a threat to their life

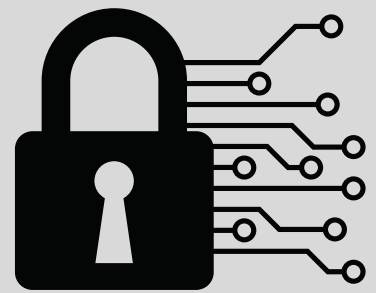


(1)E: OFFICIAL AUTHORITY / PUBLIC INTEREST TASK

Using the data is necessary to use your statutory powers or otherwise carry out a task you are legally authorised to perform

(1)F: LEGITIMATE INTERESTS

Using the data will achieve one of your legitimate objectives, and the benefit is not outweighed by the impact on the person's rights or interests



NECESSARY

Apart from consent, all of these lawful bases have a 'necessary' component - you need to show that using the data in this way is proportionate, justified and that there isn't a fairer alternative
